Primadonna values the contribution of volunteers enormously, and it is intended that all volunteering will be mutually beneficial for Primadonna and the volunteers. There are roles to suit people with different skills and capabilities. We welcome applications from Deaf and Disabled volunteers.

We recognise our responsibility to organize volunteer time effectively and sensitively and aim to make volunteering at Primadonna a challenging, worthwhile and enjoyable experience, engaging volunteers in real meaningful activities providing new challenges and learning experiences.

## What we expect of you and what we provide

We ask that you commit to a minimum of two shifts of 4 hours. In return you'll be provided with entry to the festival, a camping ticket and refreshments during or after your shift. You'll make new friends and most importantly be part of an unforgettable experience!

We are looking for volunteers who share Primadonna's values. We expect you to be:

- Friendly and approachable
- Good at talking to people
- Reliable and arrive on time for your shift
- Willing to learn
- Keen to help
- Flexible and positive when unexpected things happen

You must be 18 years old at the time of Primadonna and you should commit to attending our online training session on **18 July at 6.30pm**. Joining instructions will be shared nearer to the time.

## The roles

Please specify on your application which role(s) you would like to do. We cannot promise that we will be able to give you your first choice, but will do our best:



- Welcome Team give wristbands to festival-goers, help direct people and support with arrival. This role could suit someone with limited mobility – please let us know if this fits you.
- Camping Crew help with placement of tents and to direct vehicles; support campers who need help putting up tents. Need to be comfortable being on your feet and moving around. Some lifting may be involved.
- Welfare Angel make tea for volunteers and performers, help where help is needed. Need to be comfortable being on your feet and moving around. Some lifting may be involved.
- Stage Hand support with audience management and helping collect performers and ensuring that the production team have what they need. Need to be comfortable being on your feet and moving around.
- Event Steward help people to find other people and things, staff the information point and invigilate areas. There are roles which could suit people with limited mobility – please let us know if this fits you.
- Green Team help manage recycling and waste reduction, litter pick if necessary (not often!). Need to be comfortable being on your feet and moving around.
- Play Team help support with family and play activities. Need to be comfortable being on your feet and moving around.
- Bar Staff help sell drinks and keep the bar areas clean and tidy. Need to be comfortable being on your feet and moving around.
